## Jesus Welcomes Children

**Good News for Outsiders** 

Luke 18:15-17

Bible Point

Jesus loves everyone.

#### Purpose

Think about when you were a child. Did you ever have someone discount what you said? Now think of a time you may have dismissed something a child said to you. Were the circumstances really that different?

As much as kids are valued in our culture, they aren't considered to have a lot of wisdom. But Jesus indicated that children are important in God's family, and he was adamant about making time for them.

Young children are living out the experience of the children in this Bible passage right now. And this is your chance to let them know they're valuable and important in God's family. Jesus loves kids. And kids can love Jesus as much as adults do, serve with pure hearts, and know Jesus personally.



#### Prayer

God, thank you for your reminder that you love everyone and think we're all important. Teach me about your kingdom as I interact with kids today. In Jesus' name, amen.





## Cotton Ball Blowing


# Opening

Now's a great time for Opening Options. Choose one—or both—to introduce today's Bible discoveries.



"The Cleanup Song" (Music CD track 1)

Help kids transition by cleaning up before sitting with their Connect Crews. A Connect Crew is a smaller group of kids with one Crew Guide.



# Sing & Play

#### Welcome

Hello, friends! I'm so glad you're here today. Let's sing our welcome song.



"Hello, My Friends" (Music CD track 2)

Let's say hello to our Crew Guides. They're our go-to friends who are here to help.

Kids give their Crew Guides a hand hug.

#### **Bible Point**

Today we'll find out that Jesus loves everyone. Every time you hear the words "Jesus loves everyone!" cross your hands over your heart like this (demonstrate) and say, "Thank you, Jesus!" Let's try that together.

**Jesus loves me.** (point to yourself) **Jesus loves you.** (point to a friend)

Jesus loves everyone. (cross hands over heart and say, "Thank you, Jesus!")

Jesus loves little kids. (hold hand at your knee to show "small")
Jesus loves big kids. (hold hand above your head to show "tall")
Jesus loves everyone. (cross hands over heart and say, "Thank you, Jesus!")

Repeat several times.

Thank you, Jesus!

### **Bible Memory Buddy & Verse**

It's time to talk to our friend Buzzly Bee. Buzzly will show us a Bible Memory Buddy. Let's call for Buzzly. Do what I do!


- Flap hands quickly like a bee.
- Make buzzing sounds.



Decker Bible Memory Buddy video (Week 3)

Decker the crab reminds us that Jesus loves everyone. (Thank you, Jesus!)

- Show the Bible Memory Buddy poster.
- Explain that Decker decorates his shell.
- Have everyone point to a decoration they are wearing, like a bracelet, headband, or cool shoes.
- Your decorations are lovely! And speaking of love, Jesus loves everyone. (Thank you, Jesus!)




"So now I am giving you a new commandment: (hold hands out like a tray)
Love each other. (give a friend's shoulder a squeeze)
Just as I (point up)
have loved you, (point forward)
you should love each other." (give another friend's shoulder a squeeze)

# Bible Discovery

Hold up the Bible. **Today our Bible story tells how Jesus welcomed children. That's because Jesus loves everyone!** (*Thank you, Jesus!*)

- Get comfy and sit in knee-to-knee circles with Connect Crews.
- Who is another child you love? Briefly share an answer from your own life, then invite kids to answer in Crews.
- Crew Guides give thumbs-up when everyone has shared.

jesus loves everyone. (Thank you, Jesus!) He loves every child we talked about. They're all important! But a long time ago when Jesus lived on the earth, people didn't think kids were as important as grown-ups. It was as if the grown-ups didn't want to see them. Let's see if we can get someone to see and notice us.

- Have a Crew Guide helper stand in front of all the kids. He or she should try to look straight ahead without smiling.
- Have kids wave, laugh, or do silly things to try to make the Crew Guide notice them and smile.
- When the Crew Guide smiles, choose someone else to stand in front and try not to smile.
- After initiating another smile, have kids each give a friend a high-five and then sit with their Crews again.

We don't have to be silly to get Jesus to notice us. He always sees us and loves us just as we are. Jesus loves everyone. (Thank you, Jesus!) And Jesus noticed the kids in our Bible story. Let's see what happened!

Read aloud Luke 18:15.

Parents brought their kids to meet Jesus. Let's talk about this in our Connect Crews.

- If you could meet Jesus right now, what would you tell him about? Share an idea from your own life.
- Invite Crew Guides to share first.
- Crew Guides give thumbs-up when everyone has shared.
- Ask for a few responses from the whole group.

Thanks for sharing. We'd have a good talk with Jesus! The children in our Bible story almost didn't get to talk to Jesus, though, because Jesus' friends didn't think Jesus wanted to see them. So they said to the parents, "Take those kids away! Jesus is doing something important right now!" Do what I do!

- Wag fingers like you're scolding someone.
- Pretend to shoo kids away with the wave of a hand.
- Make a sad face to show how the kids might have felt when they were shooed away.


#### Supplies

- Bible
- "Jesus Welcomes Children" Bible Story poster

We call helpers Crew Guides. If you lead a small class, you can be the Crew Guide. Simply gather kids in a cozy circle around you. If you have helpers, form smaller groups so each child can be known—and so kids can befriend your helpers, too!

Read the verse from the Bible.
You're showing kids that God's Word is special. Don't worry—we've kept the verses short for young attention spans.

Welcome a few responses. Be sure to summarize what kids say so everyone can hear.



Jesus loves everyone. (Thank you, Jesus!) The kids didn't need to be sad, because Jesus told them to stay! Let's find out what he said.

Read aloud Luke 18:16.

Jesus didn't wag his finger or shoo away the kids. He welcomed them!

- Show the Bible Story poster.
- Crew Guides spread arms wide and welcome everyone into a group hug.
- Kids take turns opening arms while everyone else rushes in for a fun group hug.

Read aloud Luke 18:17.

Jesus explained that grown-ups can learn from kids about how to love God and be his friends. Let's practice some things kids can teach grown-ups. Do what I do!

- Kids can teach adults to notice little things—like bugs! Pretend to be a bug.
- Kids can teach adults how to be silly and smile. Make a silly face.
- Kids can teach adults how to ask for help. Raise your hand and say, "Help me, please!"

Kids, you have a special friendship with Jesus. He loves you and wants to be your friend! Jesus loves everyone! (Thank you, Jesus!)

Now's a great time for Apply-It Options. Choose one or more that fit your time frame to support today's Bible discoveries before the closing Goodbye Circle.

## Apply-It Options

Choose one—or all—of these activities to support kids' learning after Bible Discovery.

#### Game

**Supplies:** *Music* CD and media player (optional)

Have everyone move in a large circle and do fun things kids would do, such as skipping, hopping, or crab walking. The leader randomly calls "Welcome," and all the kids race to the leader for a group hug. Repeat several times. If you'd like, play tracks 5, 6, and 7 as kids move.

Jesus was teaching adults, but when he saw kids who were there to see him, he said "Welcome!" He said that because Jesus loves everyone. (Thank you, Jesus!) He wanted to spend time with kids as much as adults!

### Food-n-Friendship

**Supplies:** snack, napkins, hand cleanser, *Music* CD, media player

Give a napkin to a friend and say, "Jesus loves everyone!" (Thank you, Jesus!)



- Eat snack together.
- When we pray, we talk with Jesus. Who has something we can talk with Jesus about?
- Pray together.

Jesus loves everyone! (Thank you, Jesus!) He said kids are important in God's family! Let's work together as a family to clean up now.


### **Coloring Creation**

**Supplies:** "Jesus Welcomes Children" Coloring Creation pages (1 per child), crayons, eye stickers, *Music* CD, media player


Jesus welcomes everyone. (Thank you, God!) And he welcomed the children with open arms because he loved spending time with them!

- Identify Jesus on the picture.
- Color the picture.
- Place eye stickers on Jesus to show that he saw and welcomed kids!
- Encourage kids to draw themselves around Jesus, along with other kids they know.
- Play music as kids create.





## Goodbye Circle

It's almost time to say goodbye! Let's sing our goodbye song as we join hands and make one big circle!



"Goodbye, My Friends" (Music CD track 4)

Some of the grown-ups didn't think kids were important enough to spend time with Jesus, but Jesus loves everyone. (Thank you, Jesus!)

He loves me and he loves you, and you, and you! Point at each child.

- Show the Bible Memory Buddy poster, and remind kids that Decker helps us remember that Jesus loves everyone! (Thank you, Jesus!)
- Invite Crew Guides to give each child a Decker sticker to wear or keep for later. Have each child open his or her arms like Jesus did. Crew Guides give each child a sticker and say, "[Child's name], Jesus loves everyone, and that means you!"

Do Bible Memory Verse motions and move to the music!

Saying each child's name in a loving way helps kids simply experience God's love through you!
