




Stephen Ministry: We are weak, but He is strong.

"God won't give you more than you can handle..."

Odd, that verse <u>isn't</u> in the Bible. Job would take exception to that cliché. So would Joseph. Paul did: "We were under great pressure, far beyond our ability to endure, so that we despaired of life itself..." (2 Corinthians 1:8)



Why would God allow Paul to experience more hurt than he could handle? "...so that we might not rely on ourselves but on God. (2 Corinthians 1: 9)

The truth is that cancer is more than we can handle. So is infidelity, caregiving, rejection, death, loss, addiction, grief, prodigal children, and may other life struggles.

More from Paul, from his own experience: "But He [Jesus] said to me, 'My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.' Therefore, I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me." (2 Corinthians 12:9)

God doesn't expect YOU to handle it. He wants you to hand it over to HIM. He doesn't want you to rely on your strength, but on His. If you hear someone say "God won't give you more than you can handle" remind them gently that God has great news! He holds us in his hands, He knows the number of hairs on your head, your name is written on His palms, He has good plans for you! And the best news is that we don't have to handle this life on our own. We have the hope of eternal life with Jesus. We have eternal Peace, Joy, and Love that can only come from God. And we have brothers and sisters at St. John's who are here to listen and help you.
