As We Gather

This year, Easter (March 31) almost fell on April Fools' Day (April 1). This happened most recently in 1956, and will reoccur in 2029. Yet there is nothing about Easter that is meant to play a trick on us. We are not fools for believing. Christ is risen from the dead. His physical resurrection was confirmed by many witnesses at many times, and many at the same time. Many so-called "facts of history" have been accepted as true with far less evidence. Yet it is the Spirit of Christ that ultimately convinces us that the testimony of men (and of angels) is truth. "No one can say that Jesus Christ is Lord except by the Holy Spirit." (1 Cor. 12:3)

This Sunday we will focus on Jesus' appearance to the disciples in the Upper Room on that first Easter evening, and will concentrate on Jesus' powerful and convincing words spoken to them on that occasion. We will do so under the theme of "The Four Easter C's: Confirmation, Comfort, Commission, Courage."

First Reading: Acts 4:32-35

All the believers were one in heart and mind. No one claimed that any of their possessions was their own, but they shared everything they had. ³³ With great power the apostles continued to testify to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus. And God's grace was so powerfully at work in them all ³⁴ that there were no needy persons among them. For from time to time those who owned land or houses sold them, brought the money from the sales ³⁵ and put it at the apostles' feet, and it was distributed to anyone who had need.

This is the Word of the Lord.

Psalm 148 (Read responsively)

Reader: Praise the LORD. Praise the LORD from the heavens; praise him in the heights

above.

People: Praise him, all his angels; praise him, all his heavenly hosts.

Reader: Praise him, sun and moon; praise him, all you shining stars.

People: Praise him, you highest heavens and you waters above the skies.

Reader: Let them praise the name of the LORD, for at his command they were created,

People: and he established them for ever and ever—he issued a decree that will never

pass away.

Reader: Praise the LORD from the earth, you great sea creatures and all ocean depths,

servants, of Israel, the people close to his heart. Praise the LORD.

All: Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit, as it was in the

beginning, is now, and will be forever. Amen.

Second Reading: 1 John 1:1-2:2

That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked at and our hands have touched—this we proclaim concerning the Word of life. ² The life appeared; we have seen it and testify to it, and we proclaim to you the eternal life, which was with the Father and has appeared to us. ³ We proclaim to you what we have seen and heard, so that you also may have fellowship with us. And our fellowship is with the Father and with his Son, Jesus Christ. ⁴ We write this to make our joy complete.

2 My dear children, I write this to you so that you will not sin. But if anybody does sin, we have an advocate with the Father—Jesus Christ, the Righteous One. ² He is the atoning sacrifice for our sins, and not only for ours but also for the sins of the whole world.

⁵ This is the message we have heard from him and declare to you: God is light; in him there is no darkness at all. ⁶ If we claim to have fellowship with him and yet walk in the darkness, we lie and do not live out the truth. ⁷ But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, purifies us from all sin.

⁸ If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us. ⁹ If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness. ¹⁰ If we claim we have not sinned, we make him out to be a liar and his word is not in us.

Holy Gospel: John 20:19-31

On the evening of that first day of the week, when the disciples were together, with the doors locked for fear of the Jewish leaders, Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you!" ²⁰ After he said this, he showed them his hands and side. The disciples were overjoyed when they saw the Lord.

But he said to them, "Unless I see the nail marks in his hands and put my finger where the nails were, and put my hand into his side, I will not believe."

This is the Gospel of the Lord.

²⁹ Then Jesus told him, "Because you have seen me, you have believed; blessed are those who have not seen and yet have believed."

³⁰ Jesus performed many other signs in the presence of his disciples, which are not recorded in this book. ³¹ But these are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name.
